HARRISON WINS FIRST—AND SECOND—EVER U.S. OLYMPIC JUDO GOLD

At 16, Kayla Harrison, already a national champion in judo, revealed that for years she'd been sexually abused by her coach. She not only fought through the pain of her abuse to become the first American to win Olympic gold in judo—in London in 2012—she then created a foundation to shine light on child sexual abuse and to help survivors through education and sport. She defended her Olympic title in Rio in 2016.
